Criteria for selection:

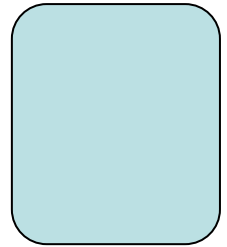
- School achievements, awards, and/or organizational involvement

Application Process:

1. Fill out the EMAR Family Scholarship application
2. Return the Application and a copy of your High School transcript to the EMAR office no later than February 25th.
3. Scholarship finalists will be called to schedule an interview.
4. Interviews will be scheduled with nominees.
5. The winner will be notified no later than April 1st.
